



Dr Brenda was awarded the Singapore Turf Club scholarship in 2014, a scholarship that had only been awarded to one other individual in the Club's 180 year history. She qualified from the University of Glasgow, UK in 2015 and spent 8 years at the Singapore Turf Club as an equine veterinary surgeon, working alongside an experienced team, which included a number of registered specialists.

Dr Brenda worked her way up the ranks and most recently, was part of the exclusive vet team for the 2022 Champion Trainer. She has also had a hand in all aspects of the clinic, from daily clinical work, regulatory inspections & surgical responsibilities.

Clinical - One half of the two-person vet team for the racing stables that trained the 2020 Horse of the Year, 2022 Champion Trainer & 2023 Singapore Derby winner.

Surgical - Part of the 24-hour surgical team as the resident anaesthetist.

Regulatory - Since 2015, worked closely with NParks regarding all import & export matters and management of equine diseases. Led the management of the 2016 strangles outbreak.

Outside of racing work, Dr Brenda also frequently attends to equestrian horses stabled at STCRC and referrals from other Singapore riding clubs. She has also been the official veterinarian for the FEI JWC 2022 (Leg 1) and National Dressage Championships 2023 which were held at STCRC.

As an equestrienne herself, Dr Brenda is in a unique position of being an industry professional and a rider. This provides her with the advantage of being able to see things from both perspectives.
