The Audemars Piguet International Polo 2010 tournament will be held at the Singapore Polo Club from Wednesday-Sunday, June 2-6, 2010. This prestigious 5-day tournament will consist of the BDG Cup Silver League (6-8 goals) and Gold Cup Match (10-12 goals). The BDG Cup Silver League will be played on Wednesday 2 June 2010 and Thursday 3 June 2010, with the Final scheduled on Saturday 5 June 2010. The Gold Cup Match will be played on Sunday 6 June 2010 with representative teams from Audemars Piguet Singapore and Audemars Piguet Internationals competing for the coveted title.

All matches will be played under the Rules & Regulations of the Hurlingham Polo Association (HPA).
