Singapore – The Singapore Polo Club is honored to announce Mr. Teo Ser Luck, Senior Parliamentary Secretary Ministry of Community Development, Youth and Sports as the Guest-of-Honour at the Audemars Piguet International Gold Cup Match on Sunday 6 June. The Gold Cup Match (10 – 12 goals) is the highlight of this prestigious tournament and will feature Team Audemars Piguet (AP) Singapore against Team Audemars Piguet (AP) Internationals. The match will again be broadcast on the ESPN Star Sports network (delayed telecast) across 23 countries.

Ignacio “Nacho” Figueras (6-goal) will represent Team AP Singapore alongside local polo professional, Sattar Khan (4-goal), Jeff Hardee (1-goal), Polo Captain of the Singapore Polo Club and also Team Captain, and Ameer Jumabhoy (1-goal), who is also a member of the Singapore-based La Sarita Polo Team that recently defeated Royal Johor in the final of the Royal Selangor International in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

Team AP Internationals will be represented by two foreign polo professionals – Craig Wilson (6-goal) from New Zealand and Mark Lillyman (4-goal) from South Queensland, Australia. Two other local amateur players will complete this quartet: Ali Namazie (1-goal), the Honorary Secretary of the Singapore Polo Club and Ang Roon Kai (1-goal), the youngest player in this tournament at 19 years of age.

Two top grade foreign professional umpires will also travel to Singapore for this prestigious event: Derek Reid (Australia) and Steve Evans (South Africa).

This 5-day prestigious tournament also consists of the BDG Cup Silver League (6 to 8 goals) that will feature four teams: Audemars Piguet Team Singapore, BDG Bank Team Argentina, Wine Investment Fund Team Australia and Equity Estates Team New

Zealand. Each team is composed of one foreign polo professional and three local amateur players (see enclosed Team List); with all teams competing in a round-robin format for the BDG Cup Silver League title. The BDG Cup Silver League will be played on Wednesday 2 June and Thursday 3 June from 4.30pm onwards with the Final scheduled on Saturday 5 June (from 4.30pm onwards).

Adding to the excitement of the 2010 Audemars Piguet International Polo tournament will be several major social events. The Singapore Polo Club Annual Gala Dinner, which is usually held in conjunction with this tournament, will be held at the National Museum of Singapore on Friday 4 June 2010. The St. Regis Singapore, Official Hotel for the tournament, will also host its legendary sumptuous Sunday Brunch at its luxurious venue for selected media and invited guests on Sunday 6 June 2010; prior to the Gold Cup Match – allowing each guest to indulge in a full-day St. Regis Polo Sunday experience.
